## Marin County nonprofit taps Ops director

Bill Cullison has joined Whistlestop in Marin County as Development Operations Director at Whistlestop, a nonprofit that works with older adults and people with disabilities.

The San Rafael-based nonprofit stated that in his new role, Cullison will report to CEO Joe O'Hehir and be responsible for managing Whistlestop's development department, including donor cultivation and acquisition, and donor programs and events.

The organization stated that Cullison

comes to Whistlestop after a 14-year career at Guide Dogs for the Blind where he served most recently as Development Services Manager. Prior to Guide Dogs for the Blind, he spent 11 years at California State Parks Foundation in positions that included Donor Database Administrator and Membership Program Manager.

Cullison holds a Bachelor of Science degree from Indiana University and has resided in San Rafael for the past 26 years.
